

ACCC Launches New Benchmarking Survey

y now all ACCC Delegate Representatives should have received ACCC's new annual survey Benchmarking Trends in Cancer Care. The survey is designed to identify and compare trends in cancer care services including reimbursement and other payer trends, organizational structures, leadership roles, financial arrangements, and other issues related to the business side of cancer care. When the results are analyzed and distributed, they will allow ACCC members to evaluate their own performance relative to other programs.

The survey should take approximately one hour of your time. Here's

what you'll need before taking the survey:

- Payer mix
- Square footage estimate of your infusion center
- Number of FTEs for the cancer service line (for example, number of FTE nurses, physicians, administrative staff, biller/coders, supportive care staff such as dietitians).

The survey is expected to be repeated over three years and is a joint project between ACCC and Eli Lilly & Company.
