### BYLAWS AMENDMENTS

Bylaws amendments were approved  
by the Delegates at their annual  
business meeting in March. Changes  
to the bylaws as a result of the vote  
include clarification of the wording  
related to voting privileges and right  
to hold office for chapter members;  
conversion of the appointed Trustee  
position for the Association of  
American Cancer Institutes (AACI)  
to an elected position, and elimina-  
tion of the minimum membership  
requirement for chapters. In addi-  
tion, the membership voted to set  
annual dues for chapters at \$1,000.

The approval of bylaws amend-  
ments by the membership created a  
vacant trustee position for a one-  
year, unexpired term previously
