MISSION, GOALS, AND OBJECTIVES

At ACCC's March Board meeting, a motion was approved to amend an objective dealing with interdisciplinary guidelines. Instead of "research the feasibility, funding sources, and partners to develop useful interdisciplinary guidelines....," the new objective reads

"initiate the development of interdisciplinary guidelines." The change was made to reflect the rapid progress being made in carrying out this goal. The final, approved Mission, Goals, and Objectives for 1995-96 were presented to the membership at the House of Delegates meeting on Friday, March 17, 1995.
