

#### **RATINGS SUMMARY** SOLID DEMOCRAT **SOLID REPUBLICAN** 192 ■ **Solid:** These races are not considered competitive and are not likely to become closely contested. ■ Likely: These races are not considered competitive at this point but have the potential to become engaged. **Lean:** These races are considered competitive races, but one party has an advantage. **RATINGS SUMMARY** ■ Toss Up: These races are the most competitive; either party has a good chance of winning. SENATE SEATS Includes seats not up for re-election. Control of Senate marked at 50 seats. **DEMOCRAT REPUBLICAN** There are currently 48 Democrats, 49 Republicans and 3 Independents in the Senate. The 3 independents caucus with the Democrats, giving Democrats a 51-49 seat majority. ■ **Solid:** These races are not considered competitive and are not likely to become closely contested. ■ Likely: These races are not considered competitive at this point but have the potential to become engaged.
