- * Recognition at the ONS Chapter Annual Conference in August Recognition at the Annual HSCO Meeting in November

Criteria for Selection



- * Experienced oncology nurse practicing in Hawaii
- * Demonstrates high level of compassion and specialty expertise
- * Mentors and educates peers in oncology nursing
- * Member of professional oncology nursing associations (e.g., ONS, APHON, APSHO)
- * Volunteer work in oncology and general community activities
- * Recipient of Oncology/Nursing awards
- * Published in oncology/nursing area
- * Practice in various oncology settings (e.g., medical, surgical, pediatric, radiation, hospice, survivorship, research, faculty)



Selection Process

- * HSCO Member to nominate deserving oncology nurse
- * Selection committee: at least one HSCO member, one Hawaii (Oahu) ONS Chapter Board member, and one ONS Conference Planning Committee member
