

Hawaii Process

- Concurrent Resolution must pass to trigger an Auditor's report
- Resolution passed in 2022, which led to an inconclusive Auditor's report ahead of 2023; not the result we hoped for
- In 2023, HCR96/SCR182 was introduced and adopted, and the Auditor's office is once again in charge of writing a report.
- In 2024, HB1624 and SB2338 were introduced.

Description: For policies, contracts, plans, and agreements issued or renewed after 12/31/2024, requires the insurers, mutual benefit societies, and health maintenance organizations to provide coverage for standard fertility preservation services for persons undergoing medically necessary treatment that may cause iatrogenic infertility. Effective 12/31/2050. (SD1)
