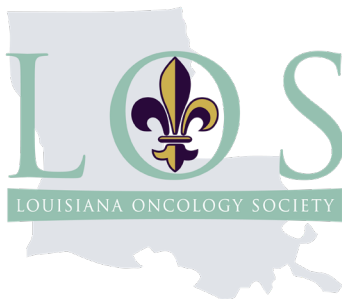

MEMBERSHIP TYPES

Regular (\$100 annually): Physician oncologist or hematologist specialists who are licensed, certified, or eligible to be certified, and practice in Louisiana.

Group Practice (\$300 annually per group of three physicians): Three physicians in a hospital, academic, or group practice who meet Regular Membership requirements. *Additional physicians may join at \$75 each. Each group may enroll up to five support (non-physician) staff with each physician as affiliate members. Additional support staff may join at \$25. ACCC Cancer Program Members may add an unlimited number of affiliate members at no extra charge.*

Group Academic Institutions: \$2,000 annually

Affiliate(\$25 annually): Allied health professionals interested or involved in the care, treatment, or management of patients with cancer.

Member-in-Training (complimentary): Healthcare professionals enrolled in an oncology subspecialty training program in Louisiana.

Retired (complimentary): Retired oncologists who are eligible for Regular Membership.
