Cancer burden in New Mexico

According to ACS *Cancer Facts & Figures 2022*

11,030 New Mexicans will be diagnosed with new cancers in 2022

- 1,700 Breast (Female)
- 1,430 Prostate
- 940 Lung
- 890 Colon & rectum
- 670 Melanoma of the skin
- 450 Non-Hodgkin Lymphoma
- 410 Uterine Corpus
- 400 Urinary Bladder
- 350 Leukemia
- 90 Uterine Cervix

The 2nd Leading Cause of Death in New Mexico

According to ACS Cancer Facts & Figures 2022: 3,830 New Mexicans

- 560 Lung
- 330 Colon
- 300 Liver
- 290 Pancreas
- 290 Breast
- 240 Prostate
- 130 Leukemia
- 120 Non-Hodgkin Lymphoma
- 120 Brain/Nervous system
- 100 Ovary

Note: About 30% of cancer death is tobacco related; About 40% of cancer death is avoidable and can be impacted by policy

2022 Legislation

Appropriations

\$5,432,500 Tobacco Cessation and Prevention

\$128,600 Breast and Cervical Cancer Screening

Policy change:

New Mexico now has coverage for tobacco cessation phone counseling on all traditional Medicaid plans.
