# Oral hygiene

- Home-made Mouth Rinse
  - ▶ ¼ tsp baking soda
  - 1/4 tsp salt (do not use in presence of mucositis)
  - ▶ 1 quart of warm water
- Rinse q 4hrs
- Do not swallow
- Gently cleans mouth
- Dissolves ropey saliva
- Neutralizes pH after vomiting
