MEMBER TYPES

Group: Licensed physicians and allied health professionals including but not limited to registered nurses, nurse practitioners, clinical nurse specialists, pharmacists, physician assistants, administrators, social workers, and office managers in an oncology practice or university.

Dues: Up to 10 physicians \$500 (Small), 11-50 physicians \$1,000 (Medium), 51-100 physicians \$1,500 (Large), 101+ physicians (X-Large). All affiliated allied health professionals are complimentary.

Regular: Licensed physician caring for patients with cancer. **Dues: \$50**.

Allied Health Professional: Healthcare staff person including but not limited to registered nurse, nurse practitioner, clinical nurse specialist, pharmacist, physician assistant, administrator, social worker, and office manager. **Dues: Complimentary**.

Fellow: Physician enrolled in subspecialty training program to care for patients with cancer. **Dues**: **Complimentary**.

Retired: Former physician or allied health professional who is no longer practicing. **Dues: Complimentary**.
