### **MEMBER TYPES**

Group\*: Five physicians in a healthcare institution (hospital or academic) or group practice who meet the requirements of Regular Membership qualify for Group Membership. Dues: \$400/group of five physicians. Additional physicians who meet the requirements may join as part of the Group. Dues: \$50 each. Each group may enroll up to five non-physician staff with each physician as Associate members. Additional support staff may join at \$25 each. Any group that is also a Cancer Program Member of ACCC may add an unlimited number of associate members at no extra charge.

**Regular\***: Licensed physician in the practice of oncology/hematology and up to five allied healthcare professionals in the practice who meet the requirements for Associate Membership. **Dues: \$100**.

Associate\*: Allied healthcare professional who has a demonstrated interest in the care, treatment, and management of cancer patients and does not join with a Regular Member or Group. Dues: \$50.

**Fellow**: Physician enrolled in oncology/hematology training program. **Dues: Complimentary**.

**Retired**: Retired oncologists who qualify for Regular Membership. **Dues: Complimentary**.
