- Patient /family consult with a Certified Hospice and Palliative Care Physician
- Symptom Management of pain, difficulty breathing, anxiety, nausea, anorexia, constipation, poor appetite, exhaustion, fatigue, etc.
- Recommendations on the management of pain and other symptoms to the medical team
- Information on the patient's disease, prognosis and treatment options to patient/family
- Assistance with establishing/clarifying patient's condition, wishes and goals
- Support to the patient/family
- Family meeting facilitation
- Social, Psychological and Spiritual support
- Assistance with health care decision making and planning for the patient's future.
