What is a Cancer Care Navigator?

A Cancer Care Navigator is an experienced registered nurse who specializes in the care and support of cancer patients and their families; whose clinical nursing expertise guides patients, families and their caregivers to informed decision-making. The Navigator collaborates with your multi-disciplinary team to support the highest quality cancer care and treatment.

Role and Responsibilities

Your Navigator provides services tailored to your individual needs, including:

- Serves as a “gateway” to Florida Hospital services, connecting you to the specialists you need, when you need them
- Assists with referrals, appointments, tests and procedures
- Helps ensure that you understand each step of your treatment pathway
- Helps you understand what to expect and answers your questions
- Provides up-to-date educational resources and information about cancer
- Ensures that you and your family have access to all of the programs and services available to effectively cope during this difficult time
- Assists and coordinates resources for fatigue, loss of appetite/weight loss, pain control, smoking cessation, wigs, and prosthetics if needed
- Being a single point of contact
